Not only are we proud of the product we produce, but also the environmentally sensitive policies we incorporate. We are committed to positively effecting the environment through eco-friendly manufacturing practices and procedures, as well as utilizing raw materials purchased from vendors that share this sense of responsibility.

Pacific Crest Industries currently:

- Is certified through the Environmental Stewardship Program of the KCMA, demonstrating our compliance to low emission and sustainability requirements.
- Is a member of the Master Builder Association Built Green program.
- Purchases SFI and FSC certified hardwood and panel materials utilized in door and case construction components.
- Offers a no added formaldehyde plywood case construction option
- Operates wood waste grinders creating recycled wood waste utilized for other eco-friendly tasks.
- Utilizes a computerized wood finishing system that exceeds environmental air quality compliance by reducing total emissions by 30%. The conversion varnish finish is free of all HAPs, and contains no reportable formaldehyde. Overspray is recycled and used for other finishing processes.
- Utilizes a solvent recycler that distills contaminated cleaning solvents and stains as well as incinerates waste particulates.
- Illuminates the factory and offices with low-energy, high-efficiency lighting.
- Maintains a healthy, clean work environment by utilizing a high tech energy-efficient variable-speed dust collection system. Heated air is returned to the factory in winter months cutting down on energy usage.
- Recycles all cardboard waste and utilizes recycled cardboard materials for product wrapping.

Environmental stewardship is not an option at Pacific Crest, but rather an ongoing commitment to incorporate the latest materials, technology, and procedures in sustainable forestry, energy efficiency, and waste management. Our intention is to leave the world a better place.
